Weather Changes; September 22; Fall is one of the four temperate seasons. **Fall** marks the transition from summer into winter, in September (Northern Hemisphere) and in March (Southern Hemisphere), when the arrival of night becomes noticeably earlier and the temperature cools considerably.

The use of word **fall** to mean autumn in **North American** English comes from the phrase **fall** of the **leaf** and it came into use by 1545 for this time of year when the leaves fall from the trees.
